



Percent of Graduates scoring above the state standard in ACT, SAT, COMPASS & ASVAB 8 Points 6 Status & 2 Progress













Five Year Comparative Revenue and Expenditures (Operating, Grants and Child Nutrition)






Compensated Absence Obligation As of 6-30-2012








FY12 Total Vendor Expenditures 7/1/11 - 12/31/11)






Tax Revenues Re-Directed to Economic Development Incentives



Percent of Tax Base Abated or Re-Directed Through Incentive Programs







Curriculum Team Support and Monitoring

- District coaches are providing onsite data team support and monitoring to all Red zone schools in the accurate use of Acuity and Ed Performance tools.
- District coaches are working collaboratively with principals and instructional coaches to insure they are addressing instructional deficiencies based on the assessment data.
- Schools are receiving differentiated professional development based on needs prioritized by the school.
- Members of data teams are participating in peer reviews to ensure classroom implementation of strategies determined by data teams.
- Principals are conducting walk-throughs to ensure implementation of strategies determined by data teams.

Addressing District Level Areas Needing Support


- Teachers are expected to reference the district curriculum.

- Teachers are being directed to use assessments created from the assessment banks to assess mastery of these concepts.


